The EMT-B course prepares students with the knowledge & skills to provide basic level emergency care in the prehospital setting. Students will learn how to provide emergency care in the pre-hospital setting. Students will learn to provide care for patients in cardiac arrest, patients with medical & traumatic emergencies, oxygen administration & pharmacology for emergency care. Students will also learn EMS operations, basic vehicle rescue, along with recognition & identification of hazardous materials.

Course is offered thru Community College of Allegheny County (CCAC) & includes classroom sessions, skill labs & requires a clinical rotation in a hospital or other approved facility. The \$550.00 tuition fee **will include** the required books & study materials for the course. Students who successfully complete the EMT program will be eligible to take the National Registry Psychomotor Exam (practical skills) & the written test.

Class will be held at the Alice Shaffer School, Linesville, PA & will be held on Mondays, Thursdays 5:30pm – 9:30pm. Occasional Saturdays are also scheduled.

Class starts Thursday, January 12, 2017 & tentatively finishes on Thursday, May 25, 2017
