Seats up for re-election:

Judge of Elections - 4-Year Term - Paid position:

- Overseer of the polling place.
- Responsible for bringing election supplies and getting the location up and running for the start of voting.
- Assigns duties to other election official staff.
- Handles any issues with assistance from Constable, if needed.
- Responsible for returning election supplies to the County following close of polls.

Majority/Minority Inspector of Elections – 4-Year Term – Paid position:

- Responsible for operating poll books, including voter check-in and any other required forms
- Transfer voter's name onto the numbered list of voters.
- Minority Inspector signs all required envelopes and paperwork alongside the Judge of Elections.
- The Minority Inspector also takes home 'Envelope B' and retains the information for 2 years.
- A 2 hour training class is required (you are paid \$25 to attend)
- You are compensated for working on Election Day.
- Election Day begins around 6am and ends around 9pm.
- You may not leave the Polling Place at any time you are working.
